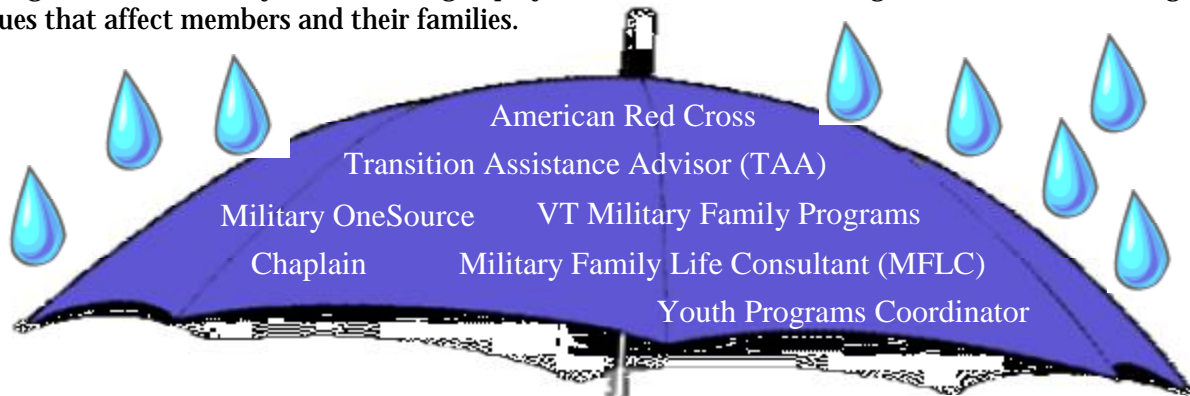


# Vermont Joint Family Support Assistance Program

## WHAT IS THE JOINT FAMILY SUPPORT ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (JFSAP) PROGRAM?

The JFSAP provides extensive support to servicemen and women and their families throughout the tough times of military life, including deployment, mobilization, reintegration and the resulting issues that affect members and their families.



## Service Members & their Families

**Military Family Life Consultants (MFLC)** - MFLC's provide assistance to military members and their families with individual short-term, problem-solving sessions, group trainings, and resource findings.



**Military OneSource** - M.O.S. is a one-stop shop of educational resources, consultations, and referrals for military members and their families to find assistance with the diverse challenges that arise throughout the duration of a military member's career.

**Youth Program Coordinator** - The Youth Program supports military children and youth emotionally, socially, and academically through events for children and youth, resources and trainings for military families, and networking with community schools and organizations.



**American Red Cross** - The American Red Cross Service to the Armed Forces program provides emergency communication, access to emergency financial assistance and information and referrals for servicemen and women and their family members.

**Transition Assistance Advisor (TAA)** - The TAA is the first line of support for returning veterans to help troubleshoot concerns surrounding their benefits, education assistance, employment, and any other issues they may encounter when they return from a deployment.



**VT Military Family Programs** - Family Programs provide training and support to military units and family members with the Family Assistance Centers as the primary POC for family assistance.

**Chaplain** - The Chaplain provides training on the "Challenges of Combat Deployments and Reintegration" for family members, community leaders and military members.
